Dear Friends:

I hope your summer is going well and that the heat is not wearing you out! By way of this week's column, I wanted to let you know about a few things that have happened and will be happening in our Saint Jude community. ***I will be away next weekend*** and week, in Connecticut for a high school graduation. In my absence, we will be visited by 3 priests who have offered to help out (even though it's June, sounds a bit Scrooge-like, doesn't it?) Fathers Joel Labauve, Eddie Martin, and Paul Gros will be with us for Masses, assisted by Deacon James. There will be no daily Mass June 18-21. Also, on June 25-26 our entire parish staff will be away for ***our annual planning days***. While our work may only require 1 day, we have allocated 2. So, please note now, that, the office will be closed. These planning days are our time to map out the coming year as best we can, reviewing our existing responsibilities and goals and setting new ones as well. Please keep us in your prayers. Sweet

Any individually wrapped sweet. Does
not need to be homemade. Ex. Little
Debbie cake, cookies, brownies, Rice
Krispy treats, granola, etc.

Beverage

One bottle of water or juice box.

Join us Tuesday, June 19th, from 5:30 - 7:00 p.m. in the parish hall as we pack lunches *together as a community*. Bring any number of items needed to complete the brown bag lunches.

One of the things offered to the underprivileged in the Gardere area is a free camp for kids. However, lunches are not supplied and most of the kids attending the free camp do not have the resources to bring their own lunches.

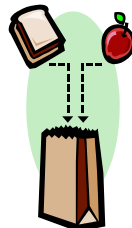
