Along with being aware of this, I wanted to let you know that any issue of concern can be reported directly to the officer on duty at the time. However, if you are unable to locate him (as he moves around, monitoring the property), please bring that issue to our ushers. They have a 2 way radio in their possession and can contact the officer when necessary. While this would include security issues, it would also include injury and/or accident, such as someone falling in or outside church. This may not be your typical summertime issue, but I thought it would be good to bring it to your attention.

On a happier note, if you see Deacon James, please congratulate him on his anniversary of ordination as a deacon, and also he and his wife, Betty, on 30 years of marriage!

Have you changed your phone number? Have you moved? Are you preparing to move soon? Are all of your children still at home and are they all included in your membership record? Do you want your record published?

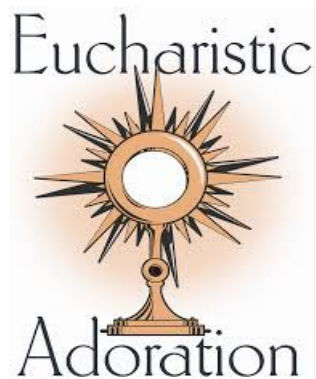
If you have not already informed the Church Office about changes to your record, please let us know now so that the information in the Guide Book & Directory is correct.
