We alternate the two ministries weekly on Thursdays 9:45-10:45 in the St. Jude Parish Hall

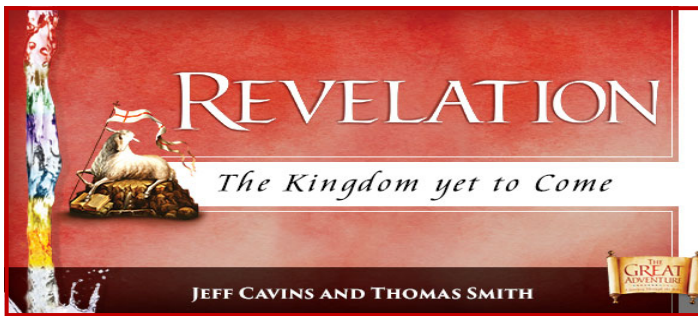
Play and Pray is a program designed to support the moms/caregivers of our parish, as well as their little ones.
